1. NEW APPLICATION: None

2. PUBLIC HEARING: NONE

3. PENDING APPLICATION:

A. Buck, Jay, applicant/owner, 25 Aquatic Road, application to repair stone wall on West Hill Lake

Mr. Buck was present and described the history of this application and the prior permit and approval by the Inland Wetlands Commission in 2012. Now that the lake is being drawn down again he would like to repair the stone wall in front of his house. All work will be done by hand with no equipment. Mr. Buck also reported that he had just come from the inland Wetlands meeting in New Hartford, as this property is located in both Towns. The Inland Wetlands commission in New Hartford denied his application, even though they had previously approved the application in 2012.

Nelson made a motion to approve the application as presented with the following conditions:

1. Activity should follow 2002 Sedimentation and Erosion Guidelines.
2. Inland/Wetlands Enforcement Officer to be notified one week prior to construction in writing;
3. Any excess materials be removed from the site; (i.e. no stockpiling)

seconded by Reeder and unanimously approved, with Simon abstaining.

4. Show, Cause, Cease and Desist

Larose, Robert, 65 Gavitt Road. Show cause, cease and desist. Status Quo

5. INLAND/WETLANDS ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S REPORT:

Debbie Brydon, IWE0 reported to the commission on a deck and handicapped ramp that was being built at 61 Park Road by the new homeowner who was unaware that he needed a permit. The deck and ramp are 50 feet from a manmade pond and the footings were already dug and filled. Debbie asked the commission to approve an agent determination as she has inspected the property and asked the homeowner to put up silt fence until all the construction is completed. The silt fence is up and staff will inspect when the project is complete. Gorman made a motion to approve the agent determination for Mark Tartaglia at 61 Park Road for the construction of a handicapped ramp and deck, seconded by Reeder and unanimously approved.

Motion to approve the minutes of September 5, 2017 made by Nelson, seconded by Reeder and unanimously approved. Martha Sullivan and Jon Simon abstained.
